Over the three days of July 23, 24, and 25, 2021, The Laszlo Institute of New Paradigm Research hosted a live online symposium on “The New Paradigm in Politics.” Engaging 35 speakers from across 12 time zones, it was a truly inter- or trans-national event that initiated a fresh and urgently needed departure from the obsolete political controversies that still dominate the daily news.

The three days of intense debates, sparked by keynotes and consolidated in break-out sessions, gave rise to the following conclusions—the bottom line:

The current and now standard philosophy of contemporary politics and politicians is seriously outdated. It is based on an obsolete concept of the human being and human society... a mistaken and now seriously counter-productive concept of nature, life and society. It creates separation and self-centeredness, encourages all-out competition, and warrants the pursuit of individual, corporate and national interests without concern for the consequences for others....

Persisting with the dominant philosophy creates an international system replete with conflict, separation, all-out competition, and violence. Contemporary nation-state politics needs a new basic philosophy: a new paradigm....

Alongside our politicians, we are all active participants in crafting this new vision of universal citizenship, engaged in transforming our current system that operates on a love for power into a new system impelled by the power of love.
